Dose Adjustment Rules - Medical

- Sickness
 - Fever
 - Respiratory infection
 - Vomiting illness
- Dental procedures
- Menses

Co-morbid Atopic Conditions

- Asthma
- Allergic rhinitis
- Eczema
- Urticaria

Activity Limitations

- Pre-dosing cool down duration
- Post-dosing activity limitation
 - During up dosing
 - During maintenance
- Time of day for dosing
- Dosing before sleep or nap

Special Circumstances

- Summer camp
- Travel
- International travel
- Dosing during vacation
- Dosing in a foreign country

Adverse Event Management

- Vomiting
 - Immediate
 - 5-60 minutes after dosing
 - >2 hours after dosing
- Oral itch
- Peri-oral urticaria
- Generalized urticaria
- Epinephrine use
 - Home monitoring
 - Emergency Department
