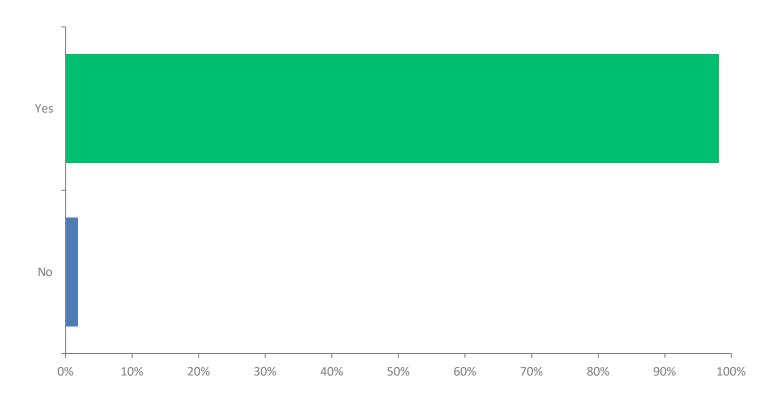
Most Commongly Used Dose escalation frequency



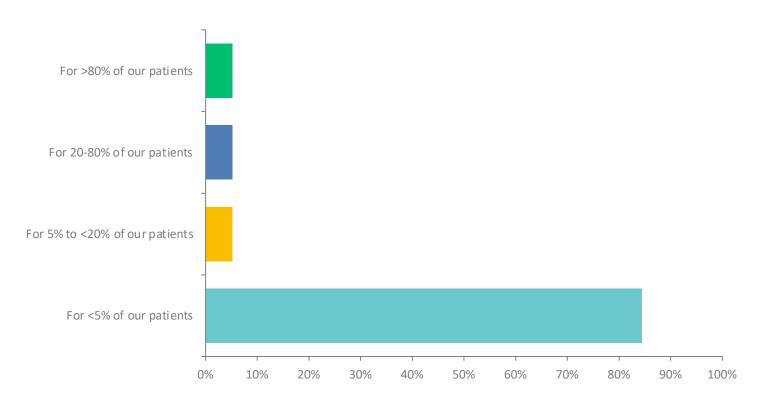

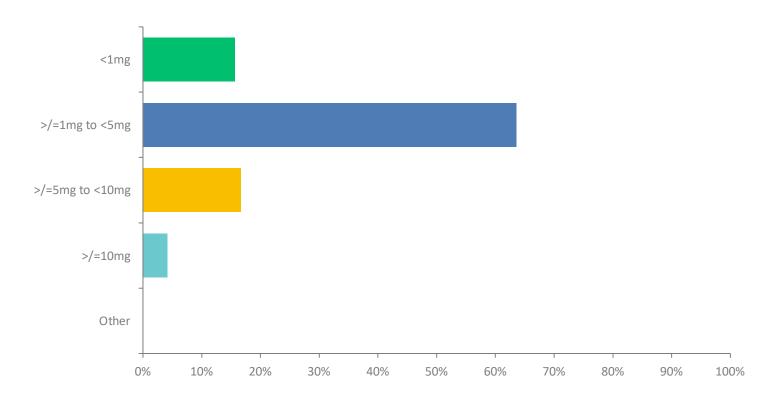




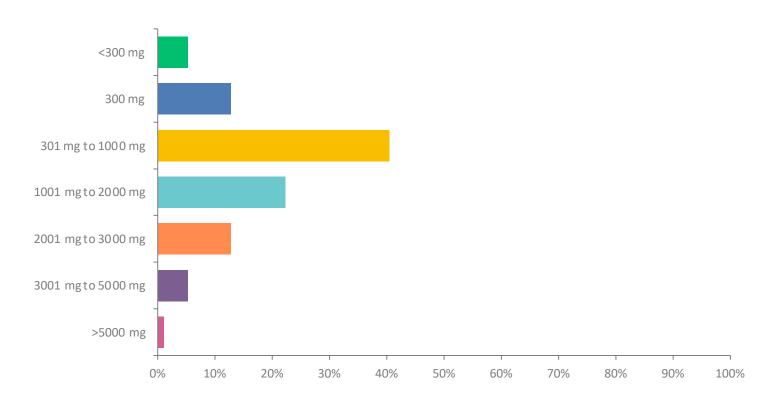
Typical Day One Peanut Starting Dose in mg of peanut protein



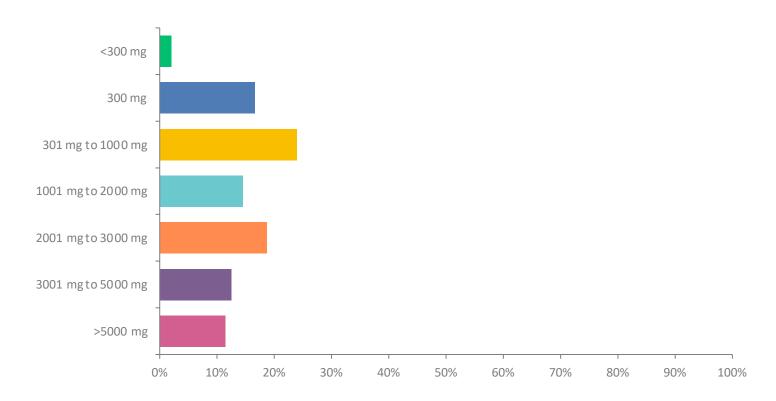

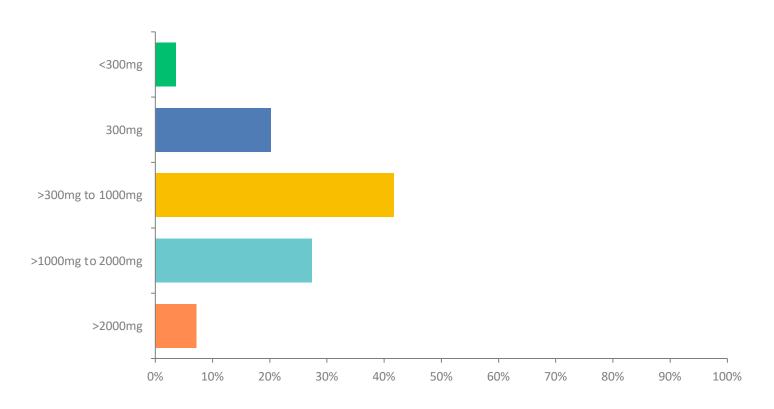
Day One Tree Nut/Seed Starting Dose in mg of nut protein



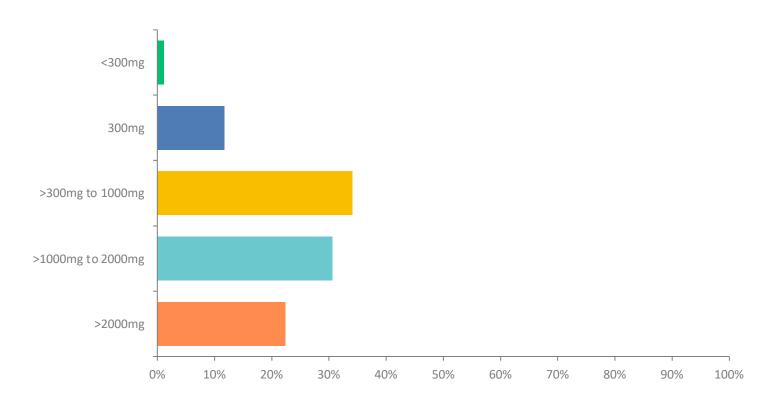

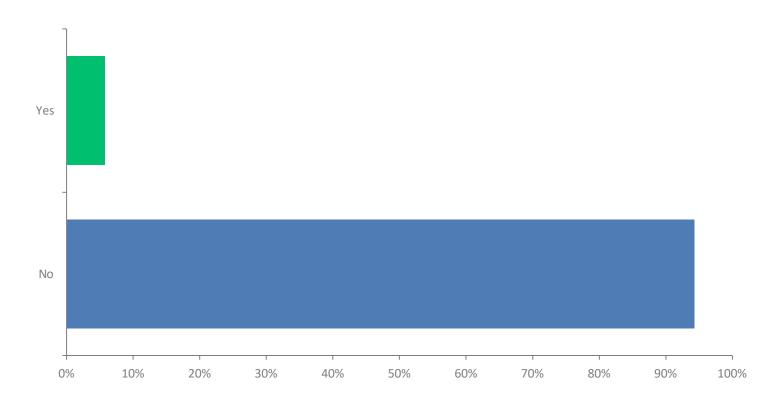
Day One MIlk Starting Dose in mg of protein

Day One Egg Starting Dose in mg of protein

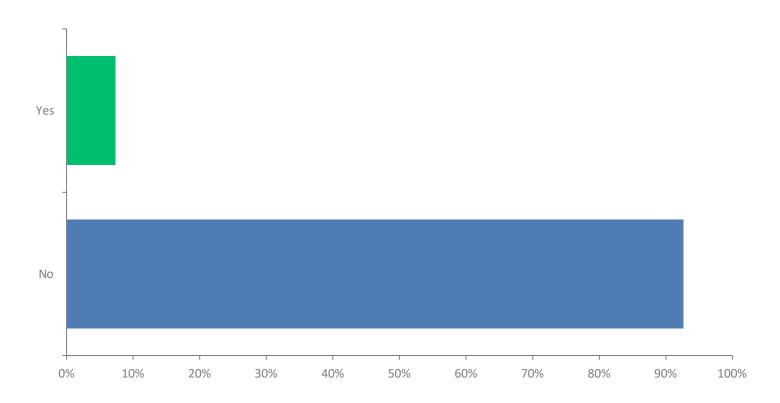


Day One Egg Final Dose in mg of protein

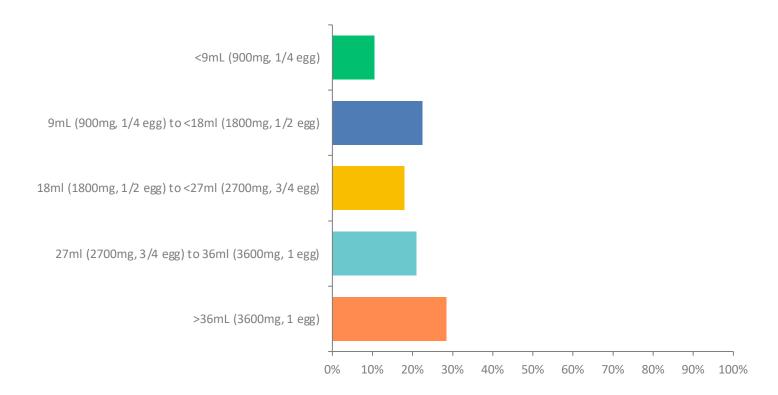




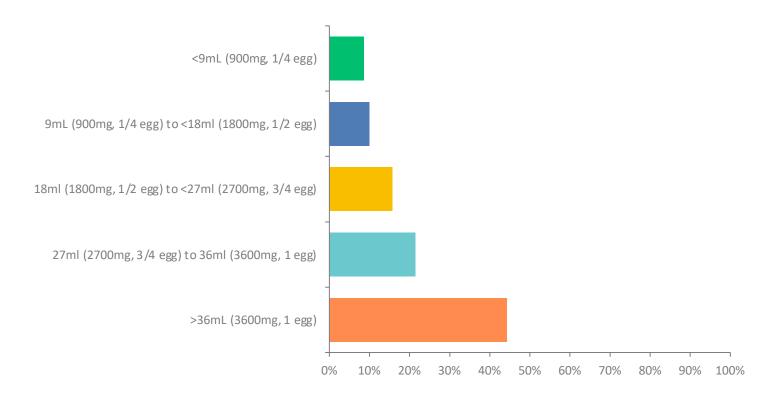

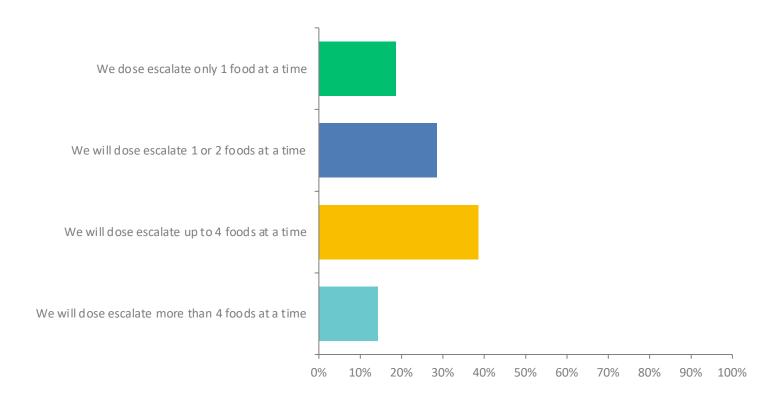

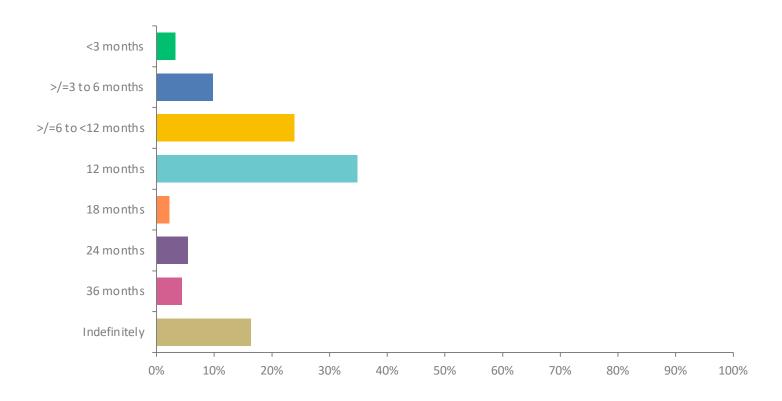

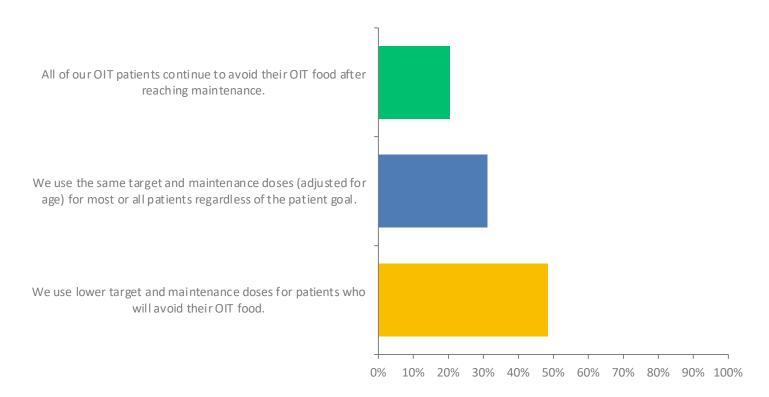

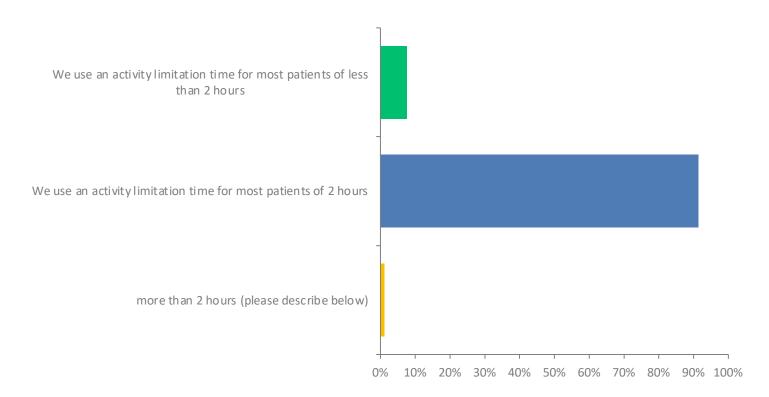

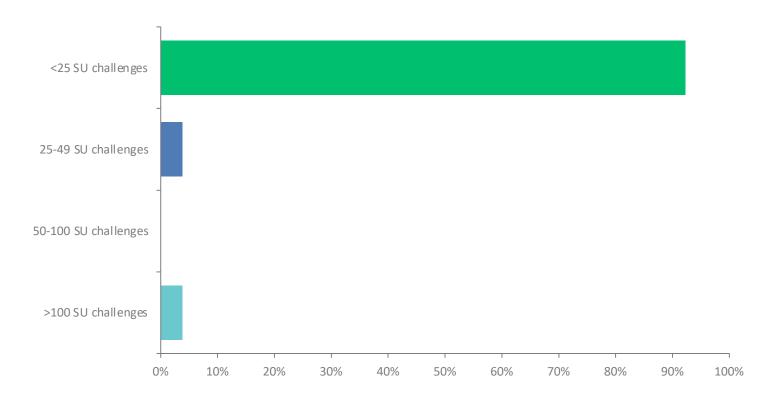

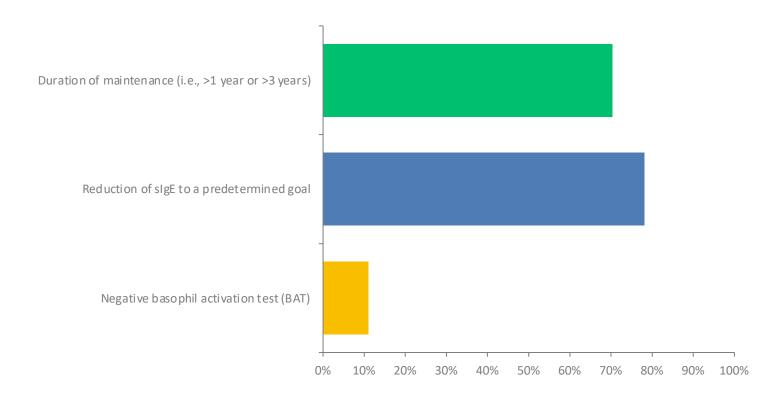

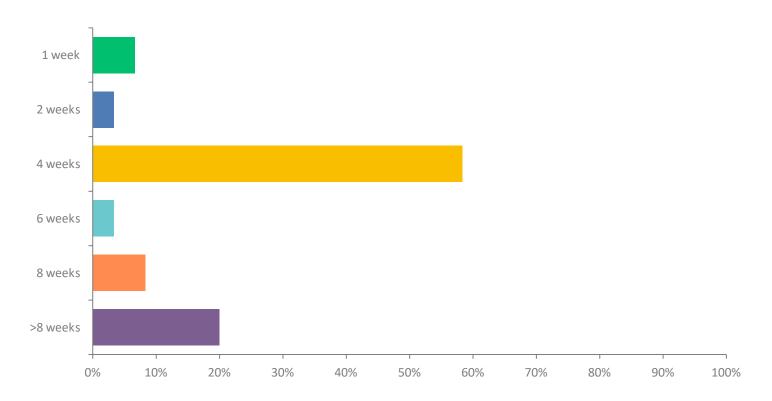

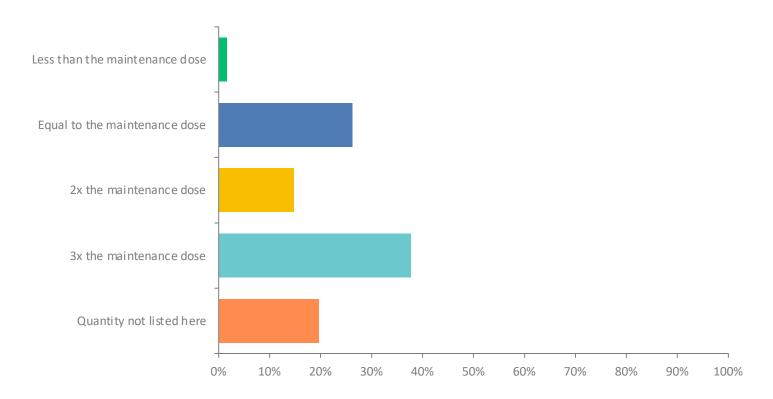

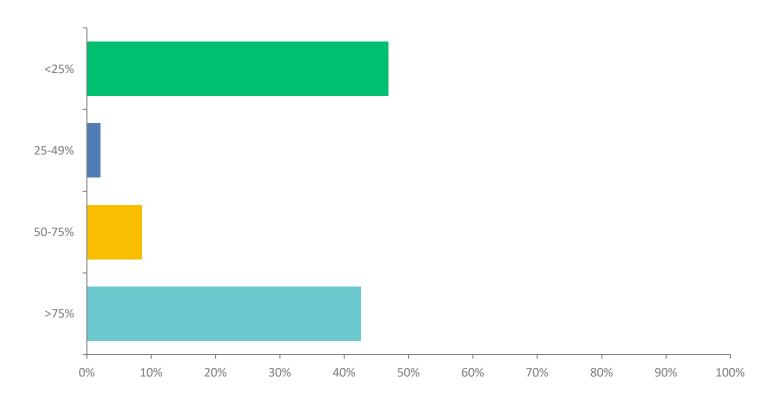

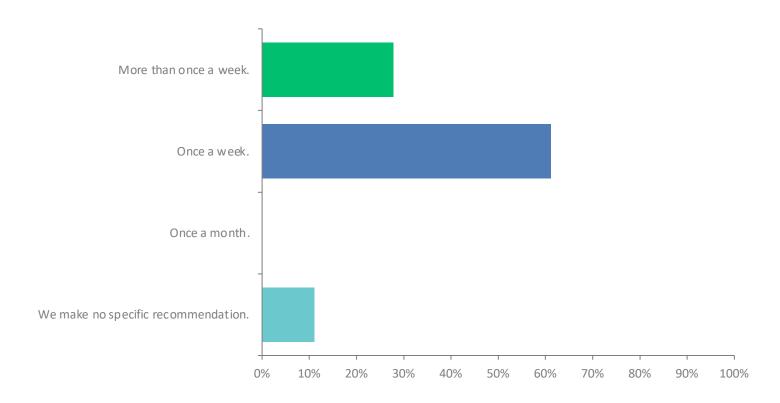

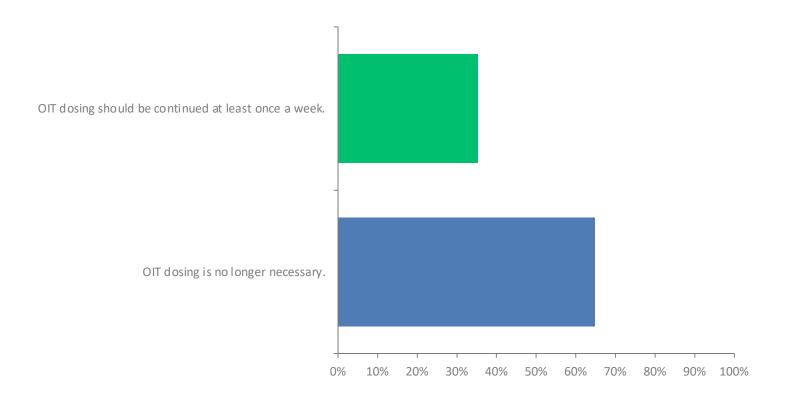
